MEMO June 10, 2021

It has come to our attention that the Gillespie County OSSF Permit Applications are not getting filled out completely.

We ask you to make sure that the landowner fills in the single-family residence/information for structure first and then also other structure(s) information under "Information for non-single residence" (i.e. barn w/bath, guest house, sq ft and bedrooms/full kitchen/washer/dryer, cabana w/bath etc.).

We have a REVISED OSSF Septic Permit Application that you can supply to your client and have them fill in all highlighted areas.

If proposing a Conventional System, then we need: Septic Permit Application, Planning Materials by installer or RS/PE, Site Evaluation and Floodplain Development Permit.

If proposing an Aerobic System, then we need: Septic Permit Application, Planning Materials by PE/RS, Site Evaluation, Development Floodplain Permit, Affidavit and Maintenance Contract.

If land is located in a Subdivision, for the Affidavit, print legibly the Client's name at the top. Also, include the Subdivision NAME and the LOT # on the Affidavit. The separate fee \$26.00 (one page) made payable to Gillespie County.

If land is not in a subdivision, include Metes and Bounds Deed Exhibits. We need the Exhibit that your client can pull out of the deed and attach to the document. First page is \$26.00 and each page after is an additional \$4.00. This separate fee goes to the Clerk's Office and is made out to Gillespie County.

Our Office's OSSF Permit Application Fees are:

\$150.00 for a Single-Family Dwelling.

\$205.00 for a Commercial - Meaning anything other than a Single-Family Dwelling.

The above goes to the Treasurer's office. Made payable to Gillespie County.

I am attaching the REVISED OSSF Septic Permit Application, the Floodplain Development Permit, and a blank Affidavit form.

You can send the packet to your client. We hope this helps get the application filled out completely.

If you have any questions or need a onetime one-on-one instruction of how to complete the form, please contact me.

All OSSF and Development Permits, Affidavit, Metes and Bounds, Checks, Site Evaluations, Planning Materials, and Two-year Maintenance Contract are to be delivered to our office.

Be sure if you give out the Floodplain Development Permit, then advise your client that I will be emailing them a FIRM MAP for them to sign and date and return to me. The OSSF Septic Permit Application will not get processed and permitted until our office has all the Development Permit Packet complete and Septic Permit Packet complete.

CERTIFICATION OF ON-SITE SEWAGE FACILITY REQUIRING MAINTENANCE

The Texas Health and Safety Code, Chapter 366 authorizes the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to regulate on-site sewage facilities (OSSFs). Additionally, the Texas Water Code (TWC), § 5.012 and §5.013, gives the TCEQ primary responsibility for implementing the laws of the State of Texas relating to water and adopting rules necessary to carry out its powers and duties under the TWC. The TCEQ, under the authority of the TWC and the Texas Health and Safety Code, requires owner's to provide notice to the public that certain types of OSSFs are located on specific pieces of property. To achieve this notice, the TCEQ requires a deed recording. Additionally, the owner must provide proof of the recording to the OSSF permitting authority. This deed certification is not a representation or warranty by the TCEQ of the suitability of this OSSF, nor does it constitute any guarantee by the TCEQ that the appropriate OSSF was installed.
